Appendix B

Clery Act Crimes and Clery Act Geography Definitions

Clery Act Crimes

(1) Murder (including non-fatal strangulation): the unlawful killing of a human being, or the attempt to do so, with malice aforethought, including killing a person in committing or attempting to commit a crime.

(2) Sexual Offense: a crime involving sexual conduct, including sexual intercourse, sexual contact, or sexual abuse, that is prohibited by law and that involves the use of force, coercion, or the threat of harm.

(3) Sexual Assault: a sexual offense involving the use of force, coercion, or the threat of harm.

(4) Sexual Harassment: a course of conduct involving repeated or severe offenses involving sexual conduct that creates a hostile or abusive environment.

(5) Stalking: a course of conduct involving repeated or severe offenses involving the use of electronic communication, written communication, verbal communication, or physical contact that causes fear or emotional distress.

(6) Domestic Violence: a crime involving the use of force, coercion, or the threat of harm against a person with whom the perpetrator is in a domestic relationship.

(7) Hate Crime: a crime motivated by bias against a person or group of persons based on race, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, or gender identity.

(8) Arson: the intentional or recklessness burning of any structure, vehicle, or contents, whether the burning is confined or extends beyond the structure, vehicle, or contents, and whether the burning is limited to the structure, vehicle, or contents or also involves other property.

(9) Possession of a Firearm: the possession of a firearm, including a handgun, rifle, or shotgun, that is prohibited by law.

(10) Possession of a Dangerous Weapon: the possession of a dangerous weapon, including a knife, club, or other weapon, that is prohibited by law.

(11) Possession of a Controlled Substance: the possession of a controlled substance, including a drug or alcohol, that is prohibited by law.

(12) Alcohol or Drug Related Offense: a crime involving the use, possession, or distribution of alcohol or a controlled substance.

(13) Violation of a Protective Order: a crime involving the violation of a protective order issued by a court.

(14) Violation of a Restraining Order: a crime involving the violation of a restraining order issued by a court.

(15) Violation of a No Contact Order: a crime involving the violation of a no contact order issued by a court.

(16) Violation of a No Harassment Order: a crime involving the violation of a no harassment order issued by a court.

(17) Violation of a No Stalking Order: a crime involving the violation of a no stalking order issued by a court.

(18) Violation of a No Sexual Harassment Order: a crime involving the violation of a no sexual harassment order issued by a court.

(19) Violation of a No Domestic Violence Order: a crime involving the violation of a no domestic violence order issued by a court.


